

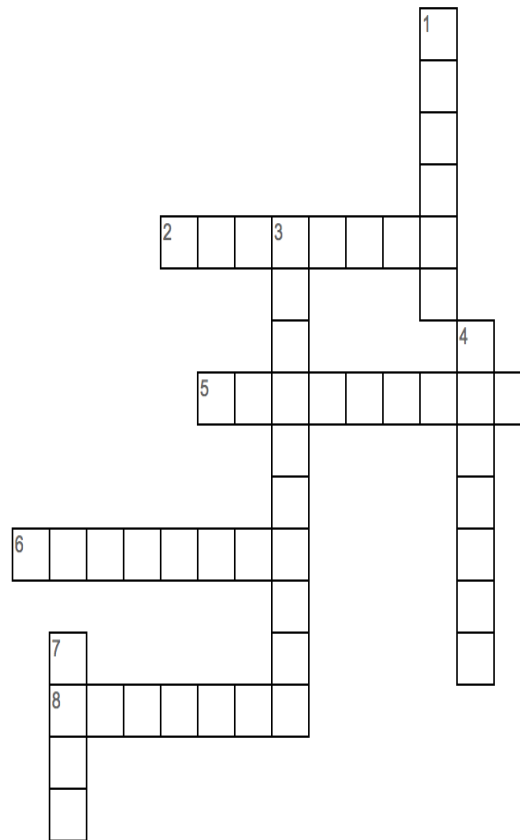


## Crossword Puzzles

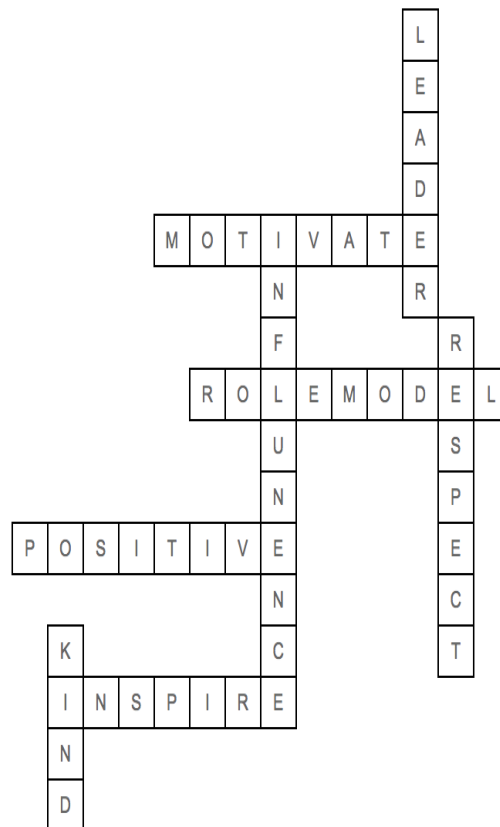
