Recommended Ages for the Game: All ages can play.

Recommended Players: Unlimited players can play.

To Set Up the Game:

- Open the file 'Cartes Quizz Recherche Clinique' and print the slides.
- Once the file is printed, using scissors, carefully cut out each outlined "card". This will be the deck of clinical research cards.
- Open the second file "Frites Recherche Clinique", print each of the slides. The slides will correspond to a game board and can be taped in order of the arrows on the slides.
- Once the second file is set up, you are ready to begin play.

To Play the Game:

- 1.) Determine the person that will be the "Clinical Researcher". This person is the one that knows the steps for a Clinical Research Project. For the first time the game is played, this is most likely the adult in the room. After the younger iCAN chapter members play and learn about Clinical Research, this title can be given to any knowledgeable player.
- 2.) Using the deck of cards, the Clinical Researcher will ask each player where they think the deck of cards should be placed on the game board for each phase of clinical research.
- 3.) While players place cards around the board, the Clinical Researcher can use this opportunity for a discussion the steps of a clinical research trial and help the players understand if they had the correct placement of the card on the board.
- 4.) The goal is to learn about Clinical Research while having fun. We encourage you to share the game with friends and play often!
